Asia's premier frequent flyer programme gives you recognition and miles with THAI, across the entire Star Alliance network and with travel partners that span the globe. Royal Orchid Plus is dedicated to making your frequent travelling a more rewarding experience.



Member benefits:

- Free membership and online enrolment for all over the age of two years.
- Complimentary extra baggage allowance for Silver and Gold members on THAI flights where weight system applies.
- 2,500 mile bonus for first THAI flight travellers.
- Upon attaining Silver status, members receive a further 3,000 miles as a threshold bonus. Gold members are rewarded with a 5,000 mile bonus for attaining this status within our programme.
- Rewards may be given to your choice of family and friends. Members may nominate five people per calendar year to claim miles from their account.
- Buy miles to top up accounts for faster award redemption.
- Claim domestic Thailand rewards online.
- Rewards include flights, hotel stays and flight upgrades (upgrades apply to fully paid tickets and may be redeemed if seats are available, once the ticket has been issued).
- One-way awards are available for redemption on THAI flights.
- Upgrades are now available on THAI and selected Star Alliance partner airlines.
- Extra luggage redemption awards are now available on flights from Bangkok.
- Spa redemption awards are available in seven locations throughout Thailand.

Earning miles on THAI

Royal Orchid Plus members can earn miles when flying THAI on paid travel in certain booking classes (W, V and G classes will not accrue miles from 01 July 2008). For THAI flights less than 500 miles in distance, you will earn a minimum of 500 miles. Miles are based on actual distance travelled. Royal Orchid Plus members may also earn miles on our Star Alliance partners. Check when booking your travels as some discounted fares may **not** qualify for mileage accrual.

We have reciprocal agreements with Air Canada, Air China, Air New Zealand, All Nippon (ANA), Asiana, Austrian, bmi, LOT Polish Airlines, Lufthansa, Scandinavian (SAS), Shanghai Airlines, Singapore Airlines, South African Airways, Spanair, Swiss, TAP Portugal, Turkish Airlines, United Airlines and US Airways. Regional partners are Adria Airways (Slovenia), Blue 1 (Finland), Jet Airways (India) and Croatia Airlines.

Important things to remember

- Make sure that you enrol prior to your departure.
- Provide your membership number to your travel agent so it's entered in your booking. At check-in make sure that your membership number is in your booking by showing your Royal Orchid Plus membership card or quoting your number.
- Only Silver and Gold members receive a membership card upon attaining their status. For online enrolments, the Royal Orchid Plus membership number will be displayed at the end of your enrolment. We would suggest that you print this number for your records.
- Ensure that all tickets and boarding passes are retained. Upon your return, check whether the miles have been credited. This process may sometimes take up to four weeks. THAI will only accept full documentation for missing mileage credit within six months of the flight activity in question.

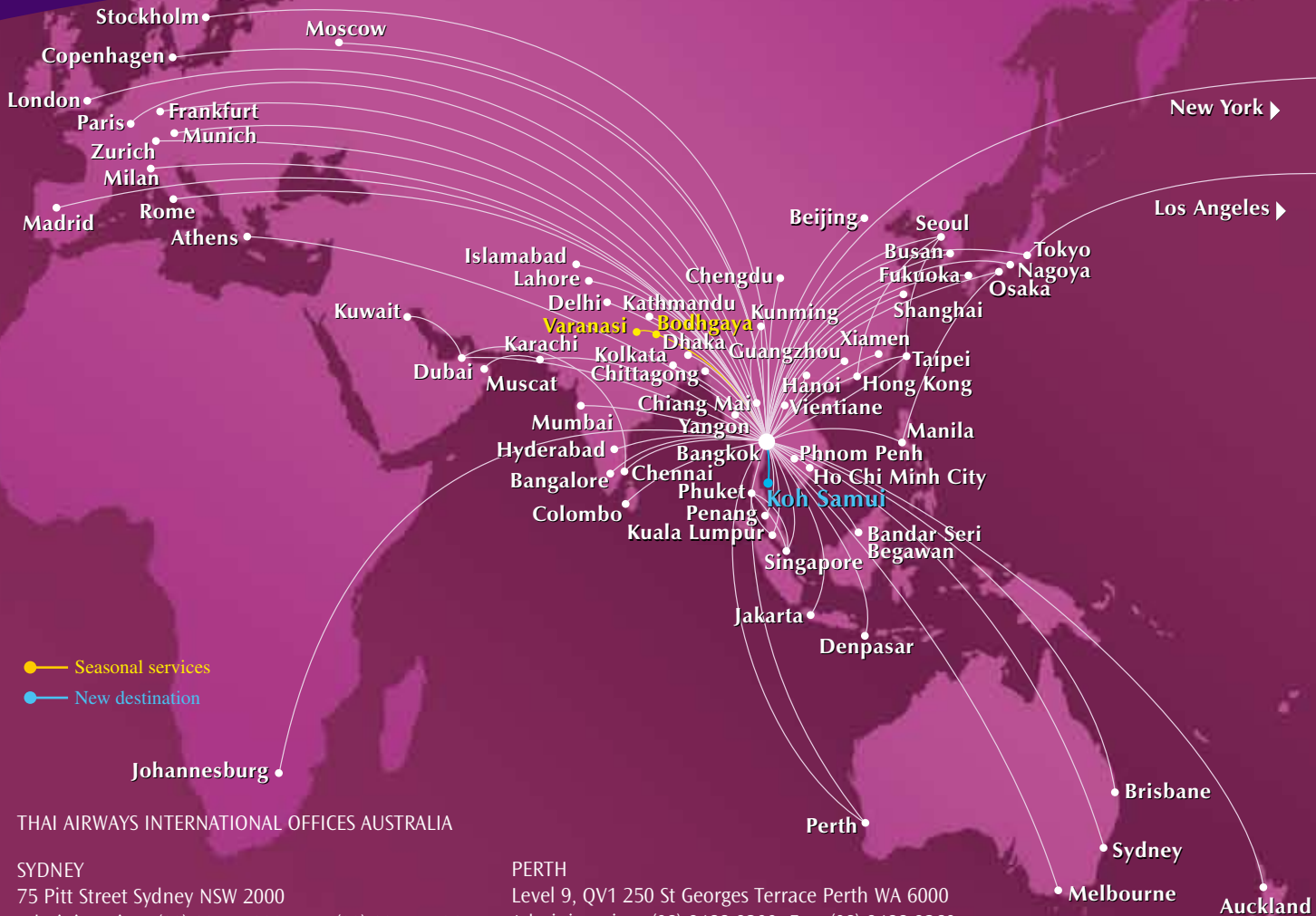
